### Dress Code

If your child is sick, please notify us each day of their absence to avoid the minimum charge. Vacation forms can be filed out in the office as well to avoid a minimum charge.

## **Snacks and Parties**

We will be providing snacks for the first few days of school. Beginning August 15<sup>th</sup> the teachers will assign one child each week to bring snacks for the week. Information about class parties will be sent home. Parents may be asked to bring in additional snacks or materials. Volunteers are welcome to help with parties. (This will depend on COVID numbers)

## **Parent / Teacher Conferences**

We feel parents and teachers need to keep the lines of communication open between each other. If parents have any questions or concerns, please contact your child's teacher.

If parents feel they have not received a satisfactory response, please contact the office for an appointment with yourself, the teacher and the administration to discuss the situation.
