Open Enrollment for 2025 / 2026 School Year

Enrollment for K3, K4, K5 opens to the public on Tuesday, March 4th.

March is the beginning of **open enrollment** for our K3, K4, and K5 classes for the 2025-2026 school year. If you haven't enrolled your child for Preschool/Kindergarten yet, please see the office to sign up before it hits the public!

A child must be 3 years old on or before Aug. 1st in order to enter K3, 4 years old on or before Aug. 1st to enter K4, and 5 years old on or before Aug. 1st to enter K5. All students must be fully potty trained. Enrollment paperwork may be picked up in the office.

Summer Camp



We will begin registration for our **Summer Camp Program** on **Tuesday, March 18th** for current K5 students, and students who were in summer camp last year. Students who are currently in K5, and will be going to 1st grade in the fall will not be eligible for our day care program this summer. If you need care for a student of this age for the summer, please enroll them in our Summer Camp Program. We will open registration to the public in April.

SPRING BREAK:

Spring Break for K3, K4, and K5 is March 24th – March 28th. Daycare will be open.

Our facility will be closed for Spring Break March 31st – April 4th.

Classes and day care will resume on Monday April 7th.

Lifetouch will be here to take spring pictures this month. Pictures will be taken on **Tuesday, March 11th** for **K3, K4, & K5**. Our **K4 and K5** students will also have graduation photos taken.

On Wednesday, March 12th, pictures will begin at **8:30am** for **DAYCARE ONLY** children.

Each child photographed will have their picture on the composite we display in the hallway. There is no obligation to purchase pictures. More information will be sent home prior to picture day.
